	Variety	Height	Light Tolerance	Soils	Notes
Transplant	Colorado Blue Spruce	30-90'	Full sun	Best in moist to well drained soils; tolerates dry conditions	Excellent for wildlife cover & windbreaks; drought tolerant
	Norway Spruce	75-100'	Shade tolerant	Prefers moist soils	Good winter cover for wildlife
	White Spruce	50-80'	Shade tolerant	Able to establish on wet sites	Found with balsam fir, red maple,
	White Pine	60-100'	Moderately shade tolerant	Adapted to most soils in its range; prefers well drained sandy soils	Great for windbreaks; a preferred deer food
Berry Bush	Variety	Description			
	Heritage Raspberry	Red everbearing raspberry; very vigorous, hardy, erect, sturdy and suckers prolifically; fruit is medium in size, red, attractive, very firm, good flavor, and excellent quality; matures late August early September			
	Fall Gold Raspberry	Yellow raspberry with subtle pink blush; fruits are very juicy, firm, and do not crumble when picked; everbearing producing a light crop in July and a heavier crop from early fall to frost			
	Blue Crop Blueberry	Highbush type cultivar; height is 4-6' at maturity and upright; ripening in mid-July; yield is 10-20 pounds per plant; fruit size is large with 65 berries per cup; berry is bright blue, firm, and picking scar is small			
	Blue Ray Blueberry	Highbush type cultivar; 4-6' and upright in growth; ripening is mid-July; yield is 10-20 pounds per plant at maturity; fruit size is large with 60 berries per cup; berry is bright blue, firm, and picking scar is small			

PLANTSKYDD REPELLENT

Plantskydd stimulates a fear-based response which will have deer, elk, moose, opossum, and rabbits looking for somewhere else to dine.

- ▶ We do not guarantee survival. Our liability ceases when seedlings are picked up. It is unlawful for these trees, shrubs and other plants to be resold with the roots attached in accordance with the Insect Pest and Plant Disease Act. PA 189 of 1931 as amended.
- ▶ No refunds on orders canceled after **October 7, 2011**; Orders not picked up will not be refunded.
